PROPOSED ORDER

A status conference was held in Court in the above cases on February 5, 1990, to discuss the Court's Order filed February 2, 1990 and the parties' progress. Counsel for Ackley plaintiffs indicated that they have not supplied additional information pursuant to that Order, and that they waived filing replies in support of the Sloan eligibility motions.

IT IS ORDERED, that the parties shall comply with the following deadlines:

February 20, 1990 - The parties shall file a current list of ripe and non-ripe eligibility motions.

March 9, 1990 - The Government's supplemental accounting report shall be served by this date. This date, which was not mentioned at the status conference, was mutually agreed upon by the parties.

March 9, 1990 - Plaintiffs shall file manifest injustice motions for the seven claimants discussed by counsel at the hearing whose A-E eligibility motions have already been denied by the Court.

If the Government wishes to raise any factual disputes with respect to the claimants in plaintiffs' Children of D Motion, it will file a supplemental response by March 9, 1990.

The Government shall advise the Court whether it will stipulate to any of the proposed deceased plaintiff representatives in respect to which plaintiffs provided additional information in their reply dated January 30, 1990.

March 30, 1990 - Plaintiffs shall file their initial brief on the appropriate interest rates to be used to calculate plaintiffs' interest award. Plaintiffs may apply for an extension if necessary.

A conference call shall be held on May 15, 1990 at 2:30 p.m. Eastern Time. The hearing will be held in Courtroom 5, Fifth Floor, U.S. Claims Court, 717 Madison Place, N.W., Washington, D.C. The attorneys in Washington, D.C. shall appear in Court for

the hearing and the attorneys on the West Coast shall be contacted by phone. Plaintiffs will make the arrangements for the conference call.
