This matter came on regularly for hearing on Monday,
October 29, 1979, pursuant to this Court's Order to Show Cause
dated October 19, 1979. The Court has considered the complaint,
the memoranda of law, the affidavits filed in support of and
in opposition to plaintiffs' motion for a preliminary injunction,
and oral arguments of counsel. It appears that defendants have
been and now are acting pursuant to a certain Regulation published on Tuesday, August 7, 1979 in the Federal Register at
44 Fed. Reg. 46269 (1979) (to be codified in 25 C.F.R. Part 55A)
(hereinafter "25 C.F.R. Part 55A") and that their actions will
result in election of an "Interim Yurok Tribal Governing Committee"

without opportunity for qualified voters to express their opposition to holding such an election. It further appears that the election is being held for the purpose of establishing an "Interim Yurok Tribal Governing Committee" without first holding an election to decide whether or not the eligible voters want such a committee. It further appears that a delay for several months for this Court to decide the legal issue set forth below in paragraph (3) will not work a great harm to either plaintiffs or defendants.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

g

- (1) Pending final judgment in this case or further order of this Court, defendants are hereby enjoined and restrained from taking any further actions pursuant to 25 C.F.R. Part 55A, except continuing with the process of the election in allowing continued voting and accepting and collecting all ballots delivered or postmarked through October 30, 1979. Defendants are ordered to hold and protect all ballots received until further order of this Court and are restrained from opening ballots or from certifying any candidates as winners of the election or as constituting any group of persons as the Interim Yurok Tribal Governing Committee. If any ballots are received by defendants in an unsealed condition, they shall be sealed without examining or noting which candidates received votes.
- (2) Because it appears that no damages will be suffered or sustained by any party who is found to be wrongfully restrained, no undertaking need be filed by the plaintiffs.
- (3) The parties shall submit further briefs on the legal issue of whether defendants have the right to proceed with the election pursuant to 25 C.F.R. Part 55A without first submitting to the eligible voters the choice as to whether or not a
