O R D E R

This case comes before the court on defendant's motion to dismiss plaintiffs' petition for lack of jurisdiction and plaintiffs' motion to bring in third party. Upon consideration thereof, together with the briefs of the parties and oral argument of counsel,

IT IS ORDERED that defendant's said motion be and the same is denied as to claim (3) of plaintiffs' prayers for relief; that defendant's said motion is granted as to claims (1) and (2) of plaintiffs' prayers for relief and as to them the petition is dismissed without prejudice; that leave is granted for plaintiffs to amend the petition to eliminate that portion of their claims as is not within the jurisdiction of this court and to assert any claim within the jurisdiction of the court, and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that plaintiffs' motion to bring in third party be and the same is denied.
