## FINAL ORDER DIRECTING THE ENTRY OF JUDGMENTS

Pursuant to the applicable opinions and orders, reported and unreported, the Court directs the Clerk of the Court to enter judgments as follows.

First, it is adjudged that the plaintiffs on Appendix A represented by DUKE, GERSTEL, SHEARER and BREGANTE qualify and are entitled to recover the sums plus interest stated in Appendix A. The Court directs the entry of judgments on behalf of all qualified plaintiffs, or the estates of the listed deceased plaintiffs, together with post-judgment interest, if permitted by law, and costs against the United States.

Second, it is adjudged that the plaintiffs on Appendix B represented by FAULKNER, SHEEHAN and WUNSCH/ HELLER, EHRMAN qualify and are entitled to recover the sumsplus interest stated in Appendix B. The Court directs the entry of judgments on behalf of all qualified plaintiffs, or the estates of the listed

deceased plaintiffs, together with post-judgment interest, if permitted by law, and costs against the United States.

Third, the Court directs that there shall be deducted from each qualified plaintiff's total payment 6 1/2%, as contractual attorneys' fees, with the total amount of those fees to be paid in lump sum to the law firms listed on Appendix A and Appendix B at the same time the plaintiffs' awards are paid.

Fourth, it is adjudged that the plaintiffs on Appendix C do not qualify and are not entitled to recover anything in this case. No unqualified plaintiffs are to be awarded court costs. The Court directs the entry of judgments dismissing with prejudice the claims of all unqualified plaintiffs on Appendix C.

Fifth, by the Order of July 10, 1986, the Court held that the 75 plaintiffs on Appendix D are not entitled to recover anything in this case and their claims must be dismissed. No dismissed plaintiffs are to be awarded court costs. The Court directs the entry of judgments dismissing with prejudice the claims of those 75 plaintiffs on Appendix D.

WHEREFORE, the Court directs the entry of judgments and the dismissal of all claims raised by any unqualified or dismissed plaintiff with prejudice. IT IS SO ORDERED.
